2010 Hospital Pricing: United States*

Site license prices are arranged in tiers. Hospital staff size (number of FTEs) is not a determining factor. Hospitals that purchase a site license may also purchase one (1) optional archival print subscription at a discounted rate. The license agreement must be accepted before the activation process can be completed.

Guidelines for Using the Hospital Site License Tables

- When selecting the appropriate pricing tier for a **hospital system, trust, or authority**, count only campuses with inpatient facilities. Outpatient facilities and laboratories are not counted when determining pricing tiers.
- Two (2) or more hospitals (*owned by a single legal entity*) joined together on a single campus are considered a single hospital.
- Teaching hospitals are defined as independently owned hospitals with contractually defined formal programs (with one or more medical schools) to train medical students and residents.
- Teaching hospitals that are wholly owned by a university are eligible for access to NEJM.org under the university's site license.
- Hospitals operated or owned by national departments, ministries, and agencies; state, provincial, county, or regional agencies; and authorities, trusts, and city governments fall under the hospital pricing program.
- If a national agency wishes to provide site license access to nonmedical related departments and agencies as well as national hospital systems, the agency needs to purchase two (2) site licenses.
